### THE VALUE OF THE WASTED FOOD IS ESTIMATED AT 143 BILLION EUR










SDG 12.3: By 2030, halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels and reduce food losses along production and supply chains, including post-harvest losses.






### EU Platform on Food Losses and Food Waste

We bring together all the actors involved and facilitate their work to prevent food waste & support the paradigm shift towards a circular economy and more sustainable food systems.





#### Waste legislation proposal:



The proposal reflects commitment to SDG 12.3 and requires MS to:

- reduce food waste at each stage of the food supply chain (including households);
- monitor food waste levels; and
- report back on progress.



### Fight Food Waste: No impact on safety of the food and feed chain



- Measure and monitor food waste
- EU guidelines to facilitate food donation
- Optimise safe use of food in feed
- Promote better understanding and use of date marking

#### EU food donation guidelines

The European Commission will develop in co-operation with Member States and stakeholders



#### EU food donation guidelines

The guidelines will help food donors and food banks/charity organisations to comply with relevant EU legislation (food safety, traceability, food hygiene, labelling etc.) with adoption forecast for end 2017.



### EU guidelines: former food to feed

- > Facilitate the safe feed use of former food
- > Hindrance due to legal uncertainty and unnecessary administrative burden should be paved away
- > Intensive consultation with authorities and stakeholders
- > Publication of the guidelines scheduled for this autumn
